FISHERIES IN MEXICO

There are two types of vessels dedicated to fishing, each with different characteristics and capabilities according to the fishing objectives. Learn more about these fishing fleets.

INDUSTRIAL FLEET

Storage capacity: **≥ 10 t**

Days of autonomy: **10**

Crew: **10-24** per vessel

Fishing gear: **≥ 2**

Target species: **48 species** (9 groups)



SMALL SCALE FLEET (SSF)

Storage capacity: **≥ 3 t**

Days of autonomy: **2-3**

Crew: **2-3** per vessel

Fishing gear: **≥ 18**

Target species: **665 species** (52 groups)



71% of total annual volume by both fleets is composed of these species






