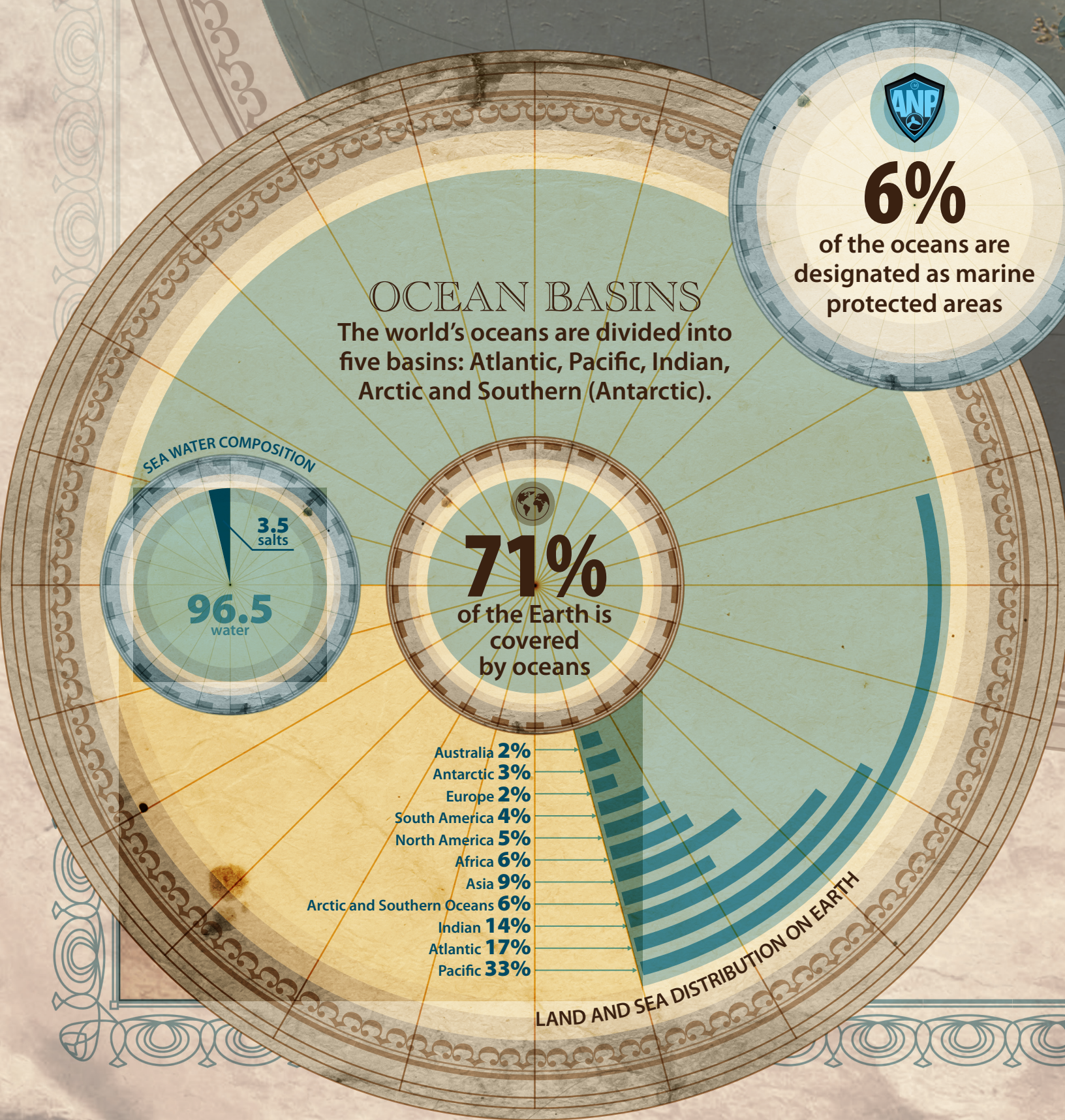
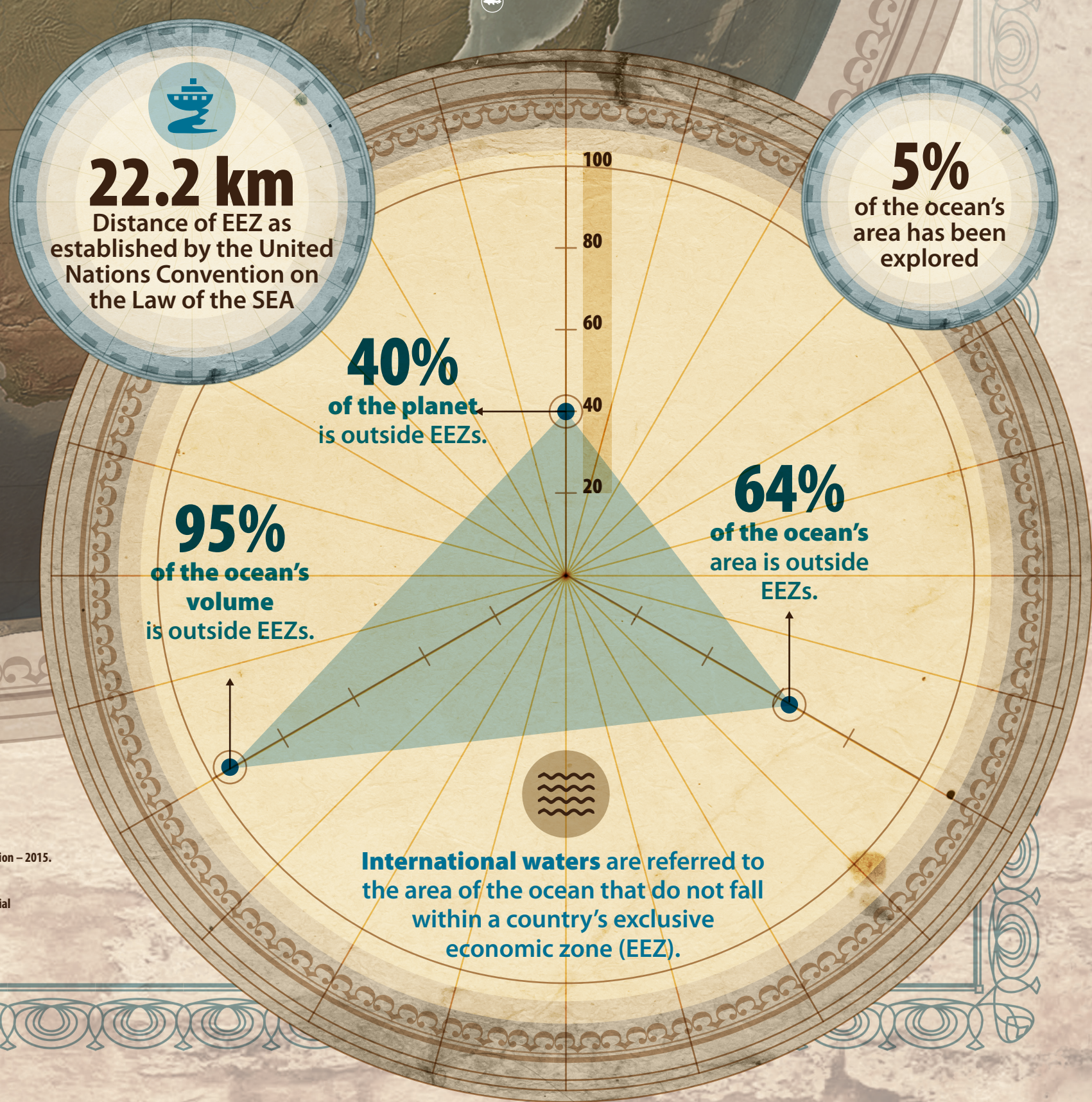
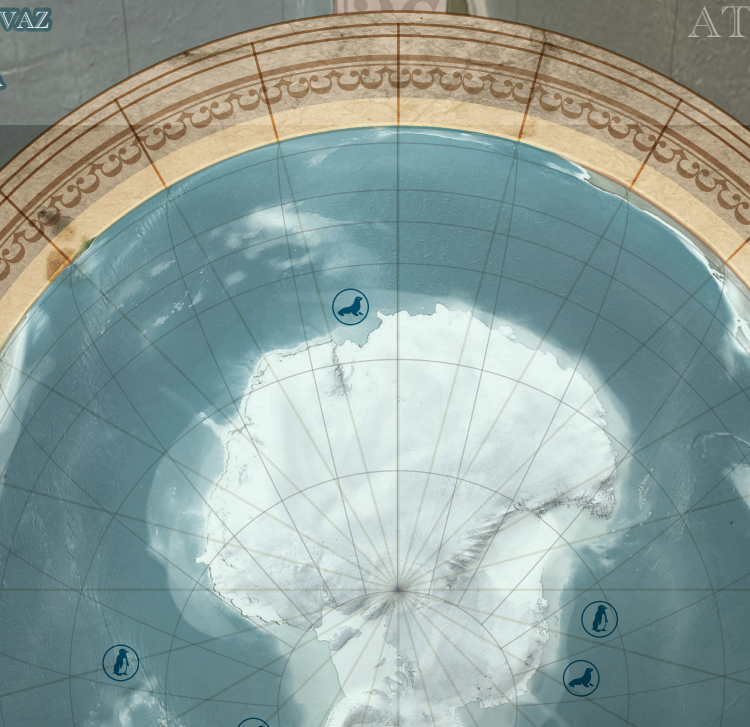
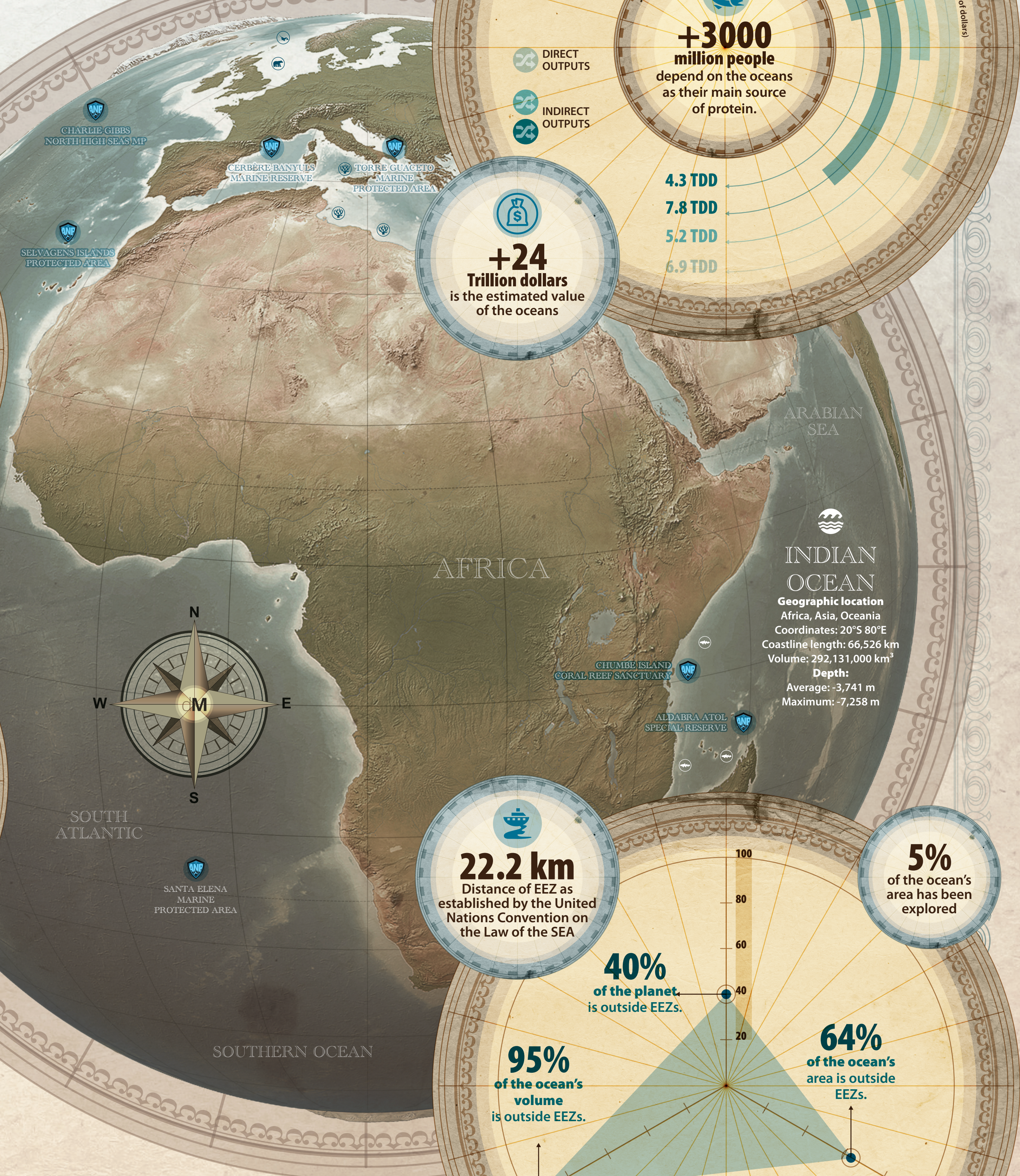
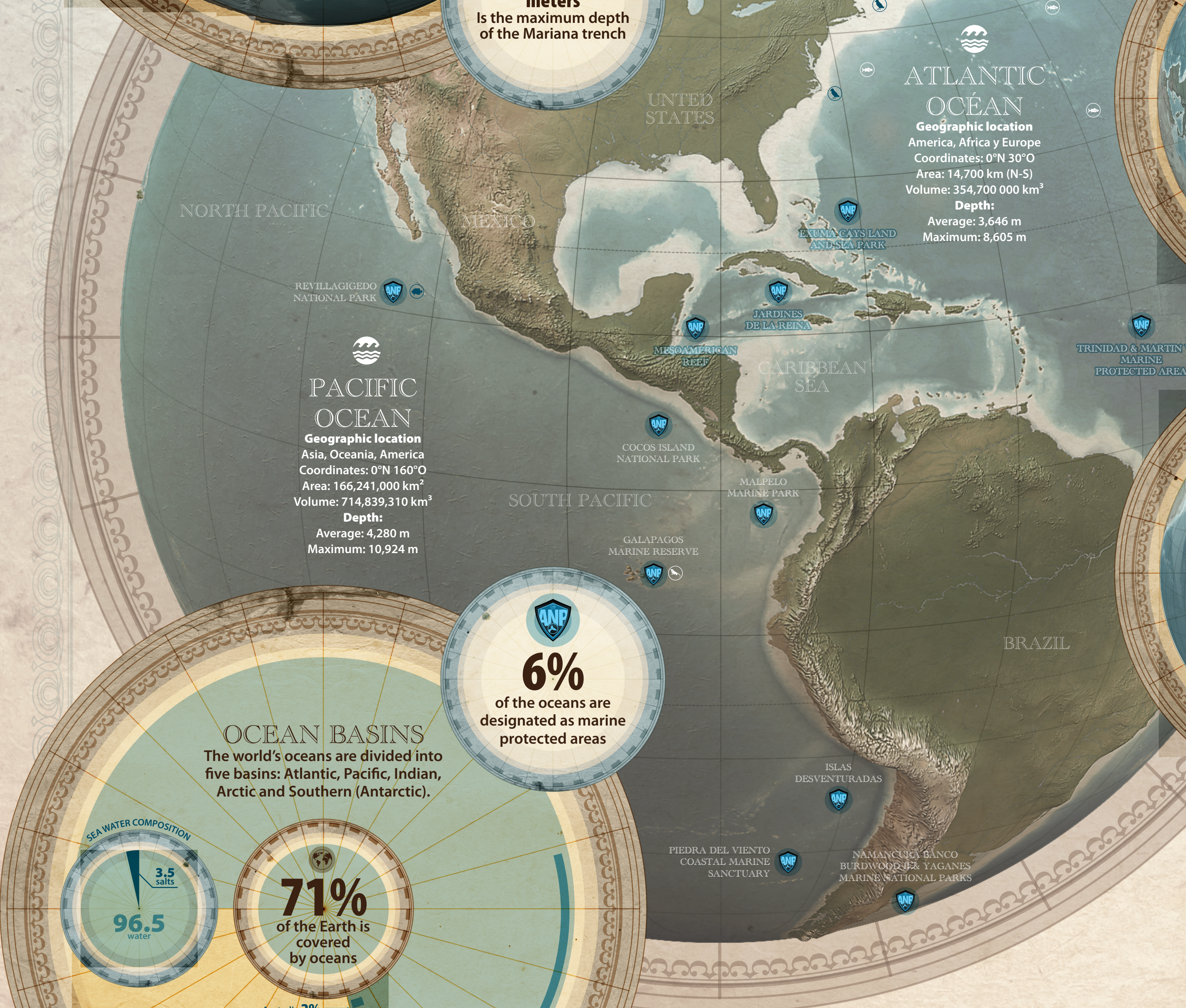
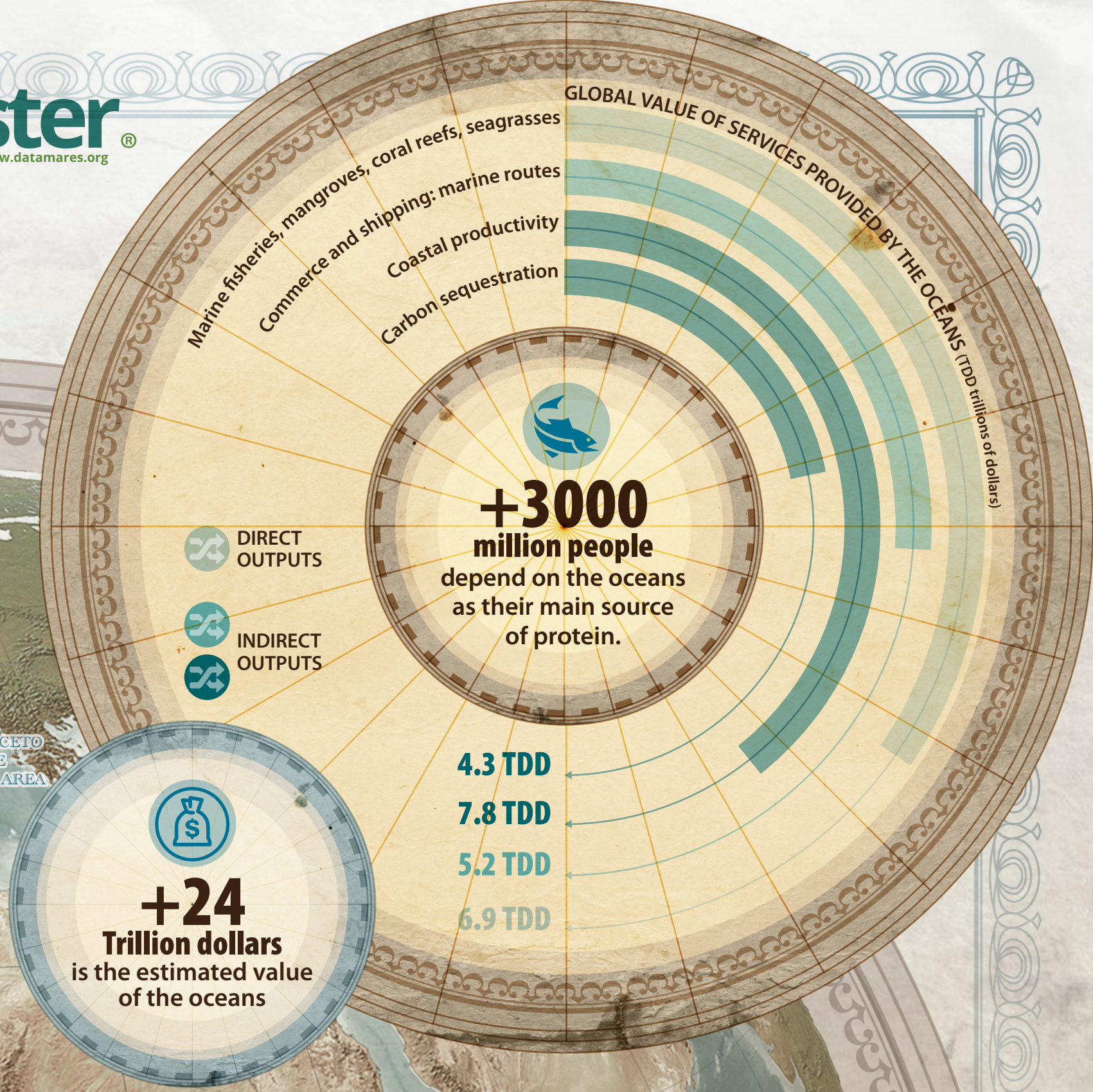
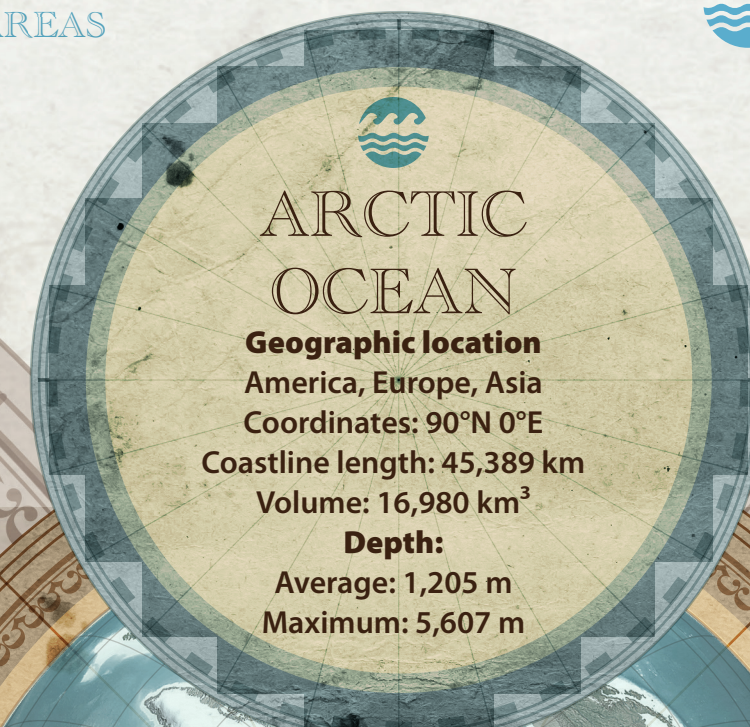


THE WORLD'S OCEANS
